### **2A MODIFIED LIMESTONE**

Sized at 1" to fine-sized limestone 2A Limestone is the perfect solution for creating solid bases. Patios, retaining walls, sidewalks, pavers, or driveways all need a 2A Limestone base.





### **2B CLEAN LIMESTONE**

Select 2B Clean Limestone when creating drainage zones in french drains and behind retaining walls. Sized at ¾" to 1" it also makes the perfect base to use under storage sheds or beneath concrete pads.

# 1B MODIFIED LIMESTONE

The ideal solution for driveways and walkways 1B Clean Limestone is ½" in size and works well as filler between pavement joints.





### **#4LIMESTONE**

At 4" in size this is the largest limestone we sell. #4 Limestone should be used for drainage areas or as a base under your gravel driveway.

## #3 LIMESTONE

Can also be used for drainage areas or for a base under your gravel driveway. Do not use it as a driveway surface. Size is approximately 3".





### **RICE LIMESTONE**

Due to its small size at roughly ¼" Rice Limestone should only be used for areas with foot traffic. Ideal for playgrounds and landscape areas.

## STONE DUST

Can be used for protection around underground utility lines, walking paths, or for leveling under natural stone. Do not use it in any area that will carry vehicular traffic.
